- Commercial UAS knowledge/experience ideally within utility inspection sectors
- Working knowledge of common commercial UAS platforms and sensors (RGB/Thermal/LiDAR/Gas Monitoring) and processing and analytics software such as UgCS, Pix4D, Metashape.
- Serve as a Remote Pilot for our UDS (Unmanned Data Services) operations.
- Serve as project manager for UDS operations within specific regions, managing all approved operators and equipment.
- Maintain UAS and associated equipment.
- Maintain operations procedures as required in Consortiq documentation.
- Maintain competency as detailed within Consortiq documentation.
- Develop new capabilities and present them to the company.
- Liaise with Business Development and Marketing to understand market requirements.
- Exemplary communication, interpersonal, and customer service skills.
